We did some freestyle trampolining in PE and in R&W we learned about Mandala art. We finished our Science assessment! HOORAH!

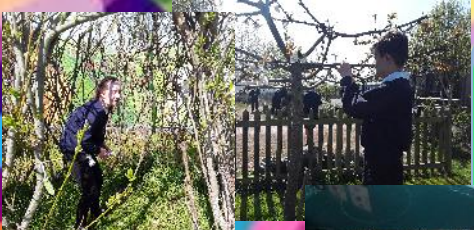

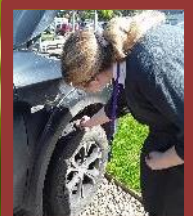
We had a visit from Skanska who did an inspiring talk on their career and what they do. We had some great questions asked.



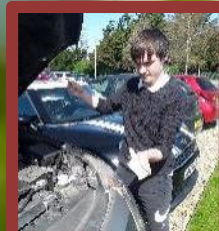
For their Community Project, 13W worked hard to prepare a buffet lunch for the Mayor and Mayoress and 80 guests!!

In Essential Skills, the Year 13s learnt how to do oil level and tyre checks on a car.





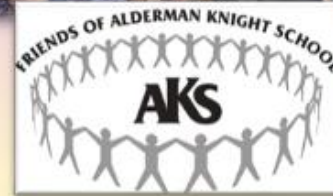

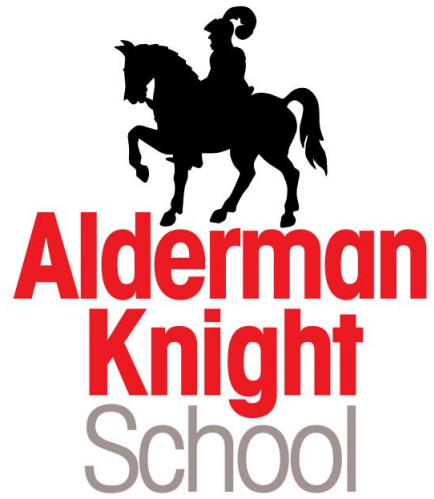

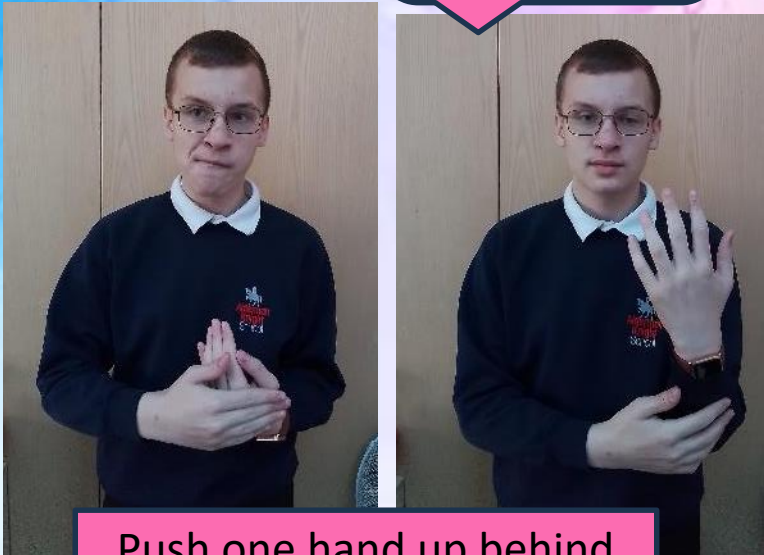
