





school.








In Forest School, we did garden maintenance! We managed to clear up some fallen leaves and plant some bulbs!









Some of the boys played in a football match against Milestones. They showed great respect and made us very proud.










In P.E we moved on to basketball and students practiced their dribbling, passing and shooting skills.
