










The Titanic




R&W: We have been continuing to compare the similarities and differences between Christianity and Islam.

English: We have been practising our phonics and handwriting.












We learnt about the value scale of colour in Art and had a go ourselves.










Everybody in Post 16 is relieved that the Mock Exams are over, and that we can get back to our usual routine!
