




Knight School Planting!








## Key Stage 4


In Music, students are continuing to prepare for their dress rehearsal on 24th February.



Year 13 and 14 have now received all of their Mock Exam results and taken on board feedback on how to improve their grades.










This included using public transport, potential hazards in the kitchen and using electrical devices safely.
