In DT we have finished sketching two scooter designs. This week we have started to use Tinkercad to create 3D designs of our sketches!




A fantastic skeleton model, by Harvey.









One of our pupils played us her wonderful composition involving chords.



Miarion received an OBE from Her Majesty The Queen at Buckingham Palace.


















On Monday we had a practical Maths lesson outside working in teams using a dice to work out our thrown coordinates on the grid.


