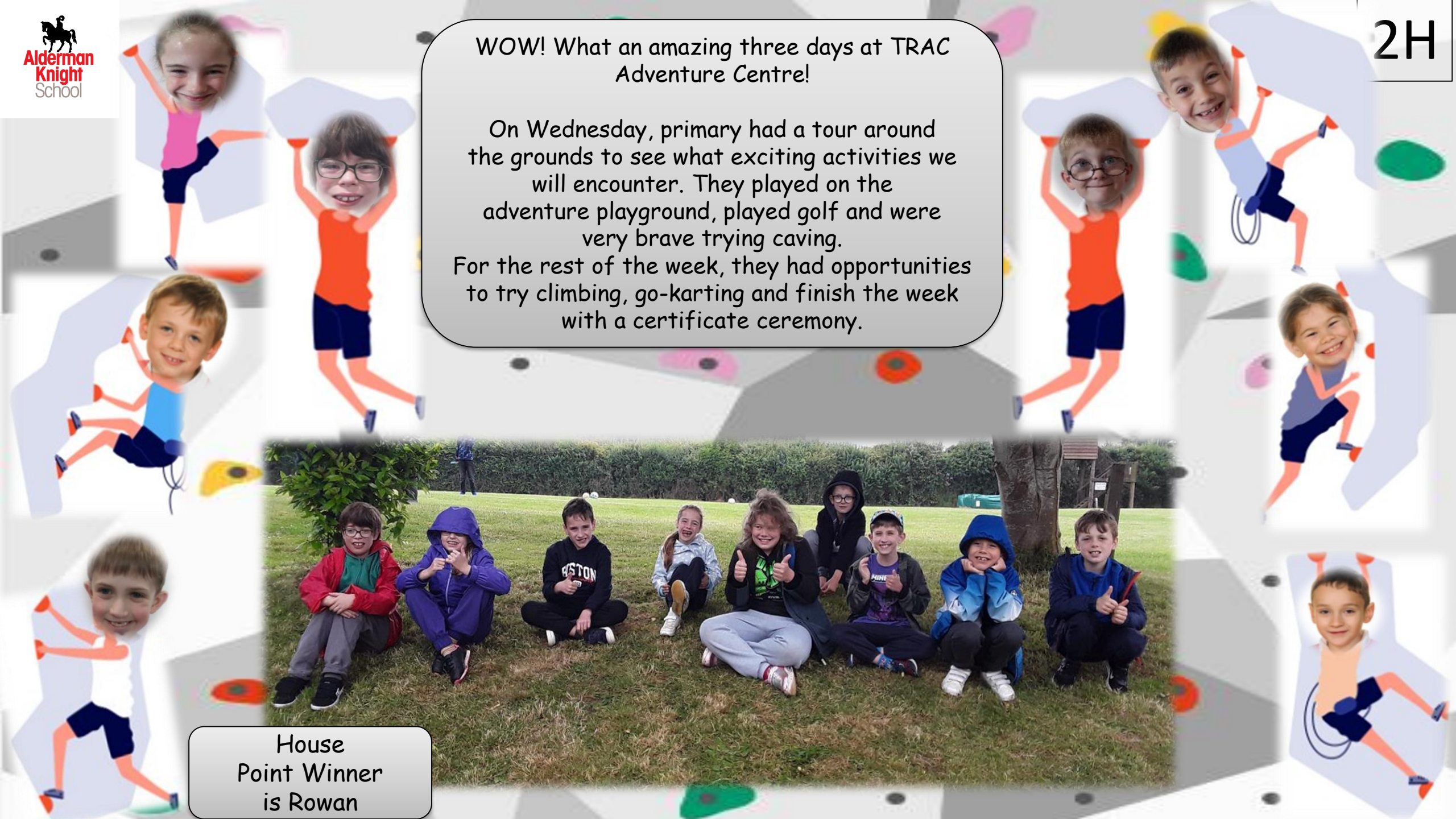


WOW! What an amazing three days at TRAC Adventure Centre!

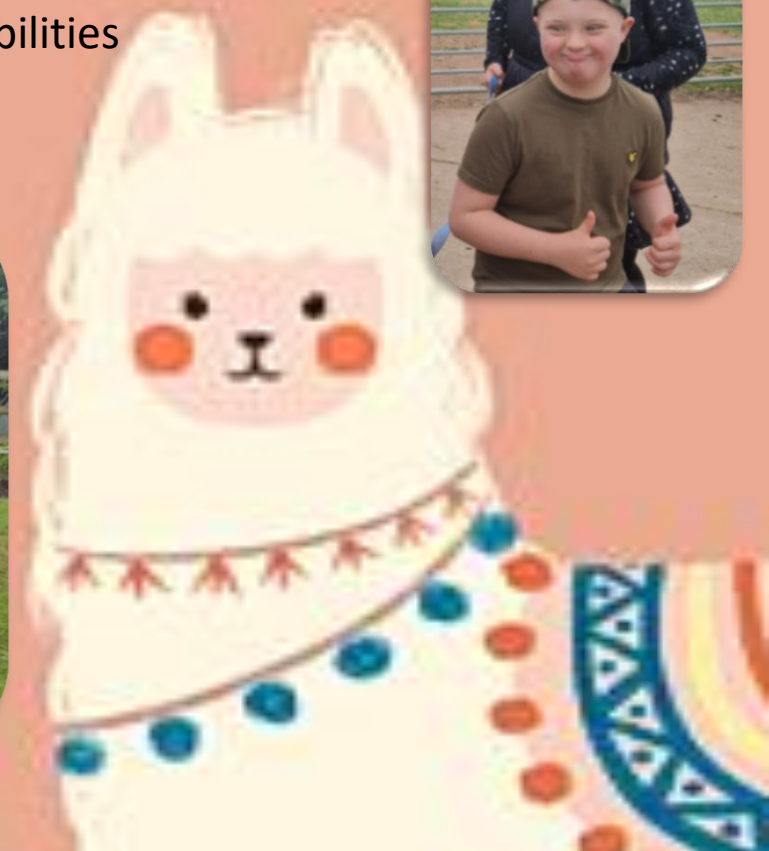

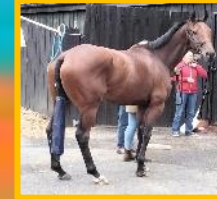
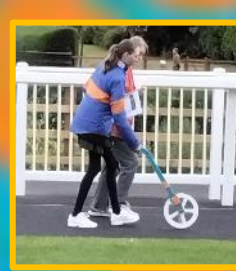
7W started looking at time in Maths and food chains in Science. We focused on reading in English and thought about the ways we can act that can affect our friendships.

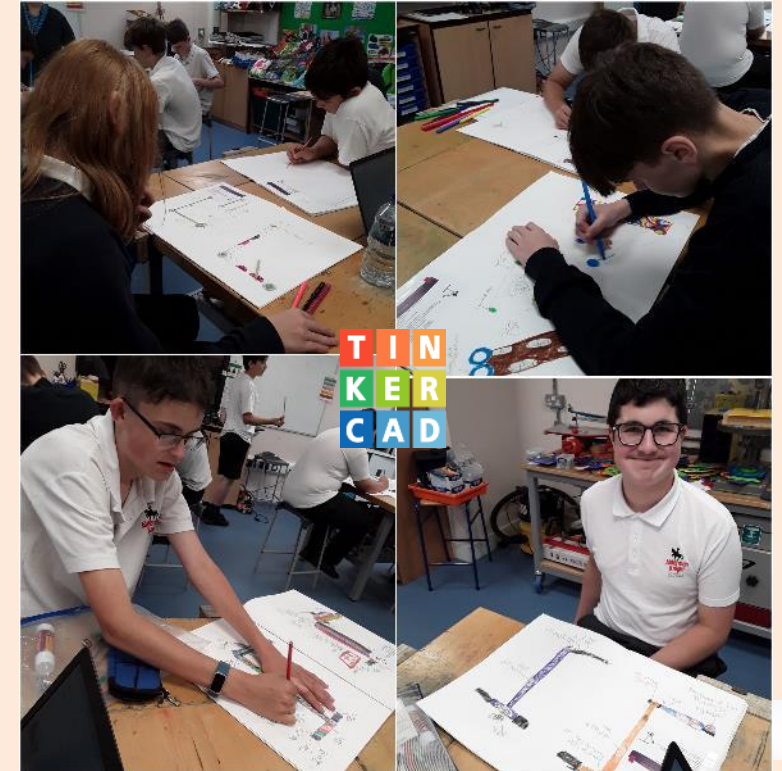

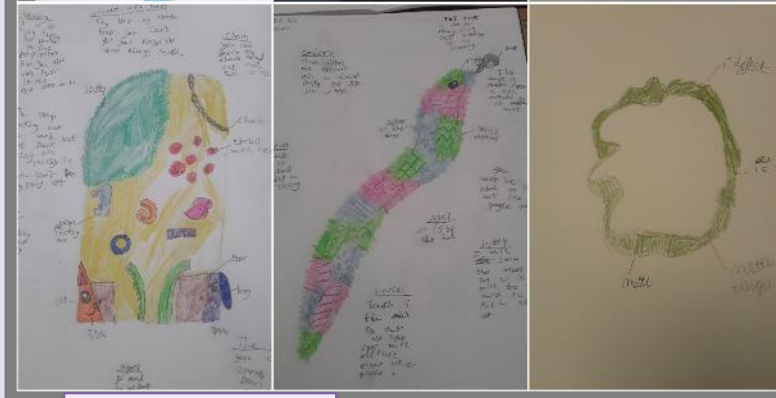
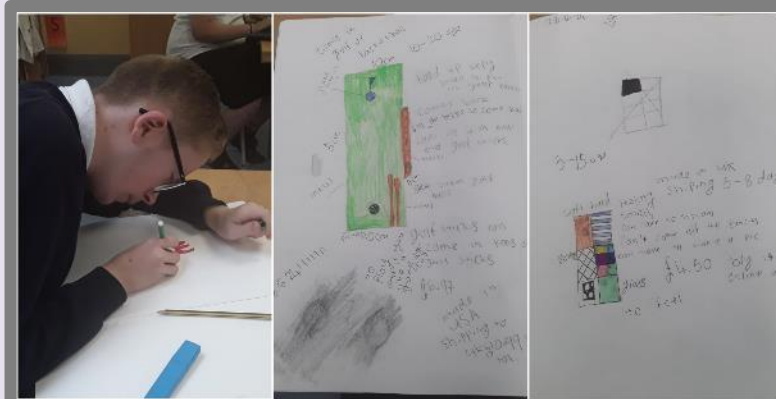


In DT we have finished sketching two scooter designs. This week we have started to use Tinkercad to create 3D designs of our sketches!

One of our pupils played us her wonderful composition involving chords.

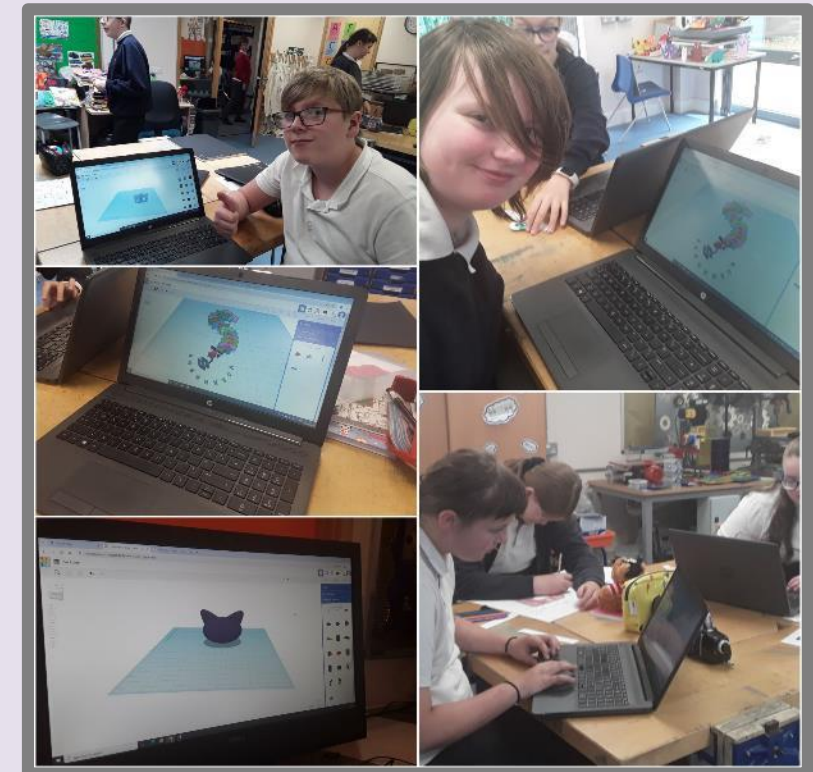

A game of Blockbusters in Maths, answering questions on percentage increases and decreases.

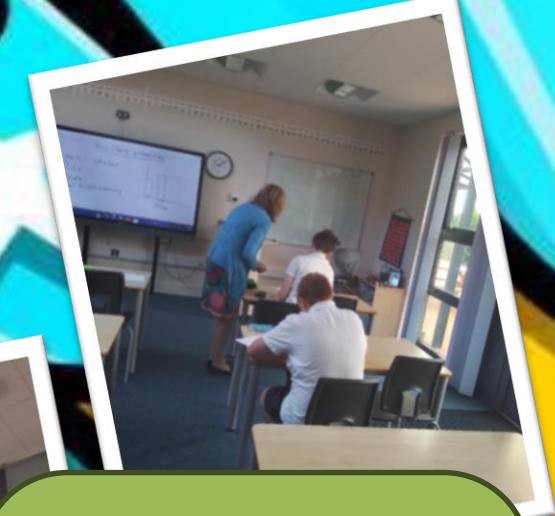
