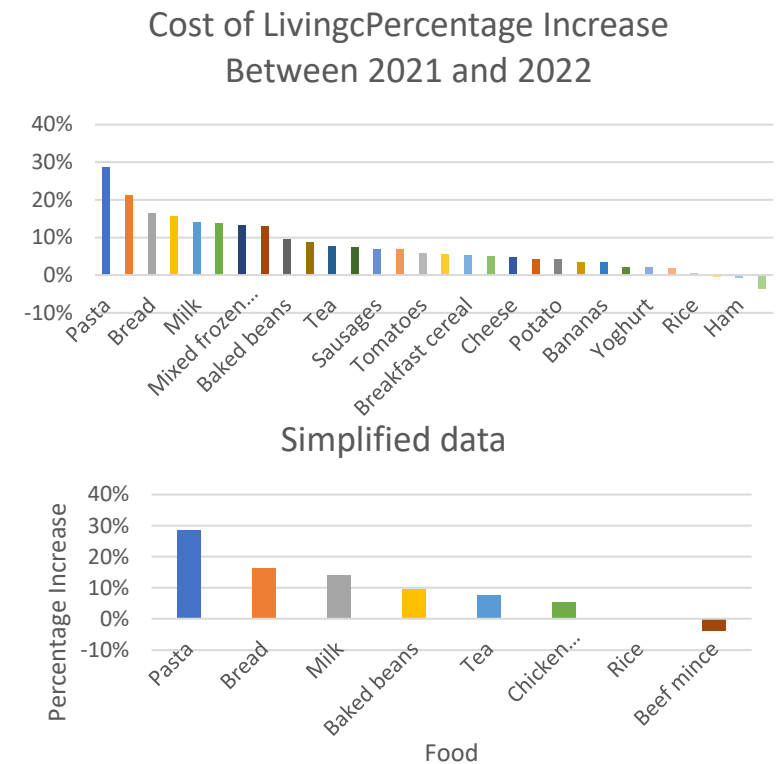
9S Dataface Project 2024

This was a cross-curricular project between the Computing and Art Departments – with many thanks to Miss Foster.

The Process

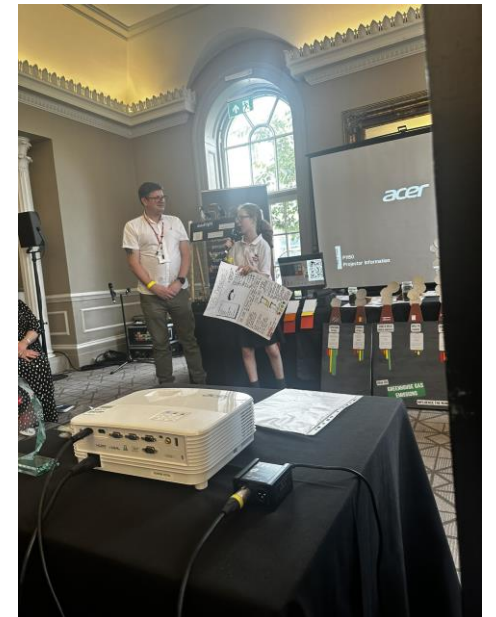
- Pupils from 9S had to learn new concepts within their computing lessons on how to ‘interrogate’ the data. They used both filtering and sorting skills, as well as learning how to use formulas and charts.
- Within their art lessons 9S had to think about the data and how they might represent it in a visual format.
- The pupils had to simplify the data due to there being too much data to represent.
- They decided on a concept for the visual representation – A Supermarket Self-Service Checkout.
- We were then Invited to the Queen’s Hotel, on Monday 3rd June, to display the finished product.
